Park County Animal Licenses:

Dog Licenses are required by the county. It helps ensure your pet is returned to you if lost and lets the county know your pet is vaccinated for rabies. 1 & 3 year licenses available. Cats licenses are optional.

Checks mailed to either 956 Wisp Creek or dropped at the WOW box will be deposited 2x per month - 15th of the month and last business day of the month.

Late fees will be enforced.
