District Water & Sewer Fee Payments

Please take a moment to fill out the attached requested information regarding your residence and return with your first water payment. This information is important to the District in keeping in compliance with Colorado State requirements. The Lottery money this district receives is based on the number of residents living in the Will-O-Wisp District and is used towards recreation in our area.

Will-O-Wisp has a play area (with playground equipment) and a volleyball court located by the upper pond. The lower pond is stocked with a variety of fish. Fishing is allowed as catch-and release only. In the winter, ice on the pond is maintained by volunteers for ice skating or ice hockey. The hut by the pond contains donated ice skates for use. Next to the lower pond is a nice picnic area. (Of course, voluntary use of these facilities is noted that you proceed at your own risk).
